## PHYSICIAN-ASSISTED SUICIDE NUMBERS INCREASING

According to a recent article by the Seattle Times, Washington state's Department of Health reported that more than 100 people died last year after requesting and taking a lethal prescription through our state's "Death with Dignity" law.

Officials said that 173 people requested and received lethal doses of medication in 2013, a 43 percent increase from the year before. Of those requesting to kill themselves, 119 died from the lethal doses. Twenty-six people died by natural causes. There were 14 additional requests that remain unreported – either because the person is still alive or their suicide has not been filed by the doctor.

The prescriptions were written by 89 different physicians and dispensed by 23 different pharmacists, the health department report said. Those taking their own lives ranged from age 29 to 95 with the majority (97%) being white and living west of the Cascades (95%). According to the report 52% were married, 95% had insurance. The majority of the people listed cancer (77%) as the reason for requesting to die by suicide.

Most of the people who asked their doctors for a lethal prescription told them they were concerned about losing autonomy, dignity or the ability to participate in activities that made life enjoyable. Most died at home and were in hospice care at the time of their deaths. - Source: Seattle Times, June 6, 2014
