July 13—I'm with you and you're with me, let's Scout out the donut scene, Scout out the coffee scene, generally just be seen...in Sullivan Hall.

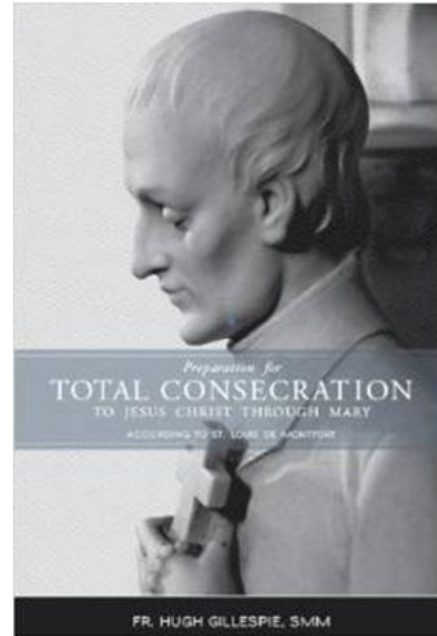
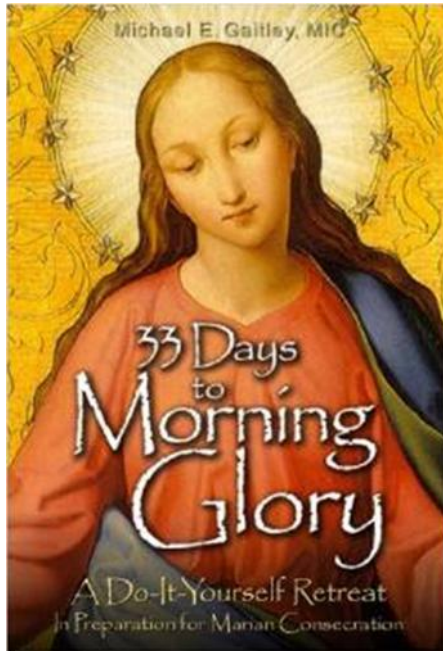

### Total Consecration to Jesus Christ through Mary

Consecration Day: August 15<sup>th</sup> - Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Preparation Begins: Sunday, July 13<sup>th</sup>

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

If you want to know Jesus, you must first know His mother! Our Blessed Mother Mary had two purposes to her life and mission. One was to give birth to the Son of God in the world. The other is to lead the world to her Son. Mary, our own spiritual mother, desires us to know and love Jesus deeply, as deeply as she loves Him. And we can love Jesus in this way by consecrating our lives to Him; by committing ourselves totally to Him!

If we are serious about becoming disciples of the Lord Jesus, then we need to let our Blessed Mother help us along. For many years, Catholics have consecrated their lives to Jesus Christ through Mary. This was a devotion that spread widely through the preaching of the French priest St. Louis De Montfort, among others. The idea is that along with Mary, a great intercessor and prayer partner, we can come to a deep and intimate relationship with Jesus. How? Well, to use a visual, Mary literally takes us by the hand and leads us into Jesus' arms, where we can trust Him and surrender our lives totally to Him.

The consecration of our lives in this way takes the form of a commitment prayer that people recite typically on a Marian feast day. But we must prepare for such an important commitment on our part. Just as we prepare for Christmas with Advent and Easter with Lent, so we prepare for total consecration to Jesus through a time of preparation, in this case 33 days. Many people have used the above book on the right, which is based on St. Louis' writings. It's good, but can be difficult for some (me included), as it is quite heavy on formal prayers and continued over .....

litanies. The book on the left by Fr. Michael Gaitley is very different. His focus is on a daily reading that, like Mary, causes us to “ponder” key truths and concepts in our hearts. I think this book provides a unique and wonderful way to enter into this time of preparation. You can find this book on Amazon.com or you can purchase one from a limited number of copies that the parish will make available this and next weekend. But remember, the time of preparation begins on Sunday, July 13<sup>th</sup> for consecration on the Solemnity of the Assumption on August 15<sup>th</sup>.

**The Total Consecration to Jesus Christ through Mary at St. Mark:**

On the Solemnity of the Assumption, August 15, after the celebration of the 7:00 p.m. Mass, there will be a public recitation of the Total Consecration to Jesus Christ through Mary in the Church along with a signing of your own consecration document, as a reminder of your commitment to the Lord through our mother Mary. If you would like to take part in this brief ceremony, please provide your name, phone number and email address on the sign-up sheet next to the books in the vestibule, or call the parish office at 206-364-7900. We will prepare a special consecration document just for you.

Dear Parishioners,

I had one of those difficult calls this week - a man calling in need of healing from involvement in a past abortion. It is particularly difficult because he and his wife are in the process of divorce. From the details of his story, I feel fairly confident that the abortion is likely the root cause. If healing had been sought sooner, this marriage may very well have survived and thrived. It is not clear that possibility remains open on her end.

Yet, our God is a God of miracles and I have witnessed them before - couples already in process of divorce who attended a retreat and restored their marriages. Even a couple where one spouse refused to attend, adamantly claiming the marriage was over. Nevertheless, God's grace was able to pour through the wife who attended, the couple reconciled and has remained together years since.

Please offer prayer for the husband who called this week, for his wife and for all marriage relationships suffering from a past abortion.
