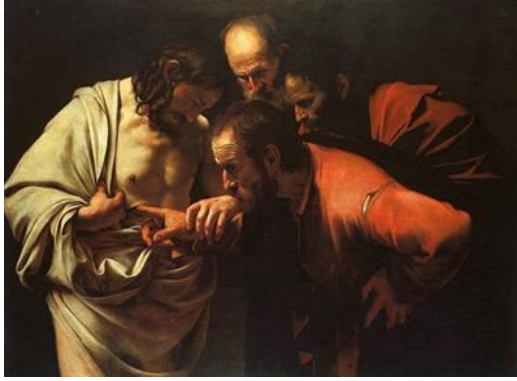
GABRIEL PROJECT
