For example, there is a great study of the faith called Symbolon; marriage DVDs called Beloved, and Bishop Robert Barron's Catholicism Project, and much more, all of which you can now access via your computer, iPad or Tablet.

Saint Mark Parish has purchased an annual subscription to FORMED.ORG so our parishioners can now access this content. The simple 4 step process to begin is on the enclosed blue bulletin insert. FORMED.ORG is a great resource for individuals and families to grow in the knowledge and love of our Catholic Faith! I encourage you to begin today.

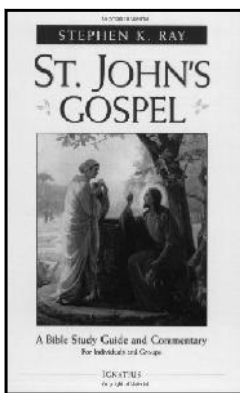
