Pastor's Letter:

Jubilee of Mercy



Prepare for the gift of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Lord Jesus' promised sending of the Holy Spirit is **THE** key event in the life of the Church after his ascension into Heaven, which we celebrate today. Here is what Jesus said:

“He presented himself alive to them by many proofs after he had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. He enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, **but to wait** for ‘the promise of the Father which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.’” Acts 1:3-5

Like never before, we need to open our hearts to receive the Holy Spirit in a renewed way this Pentecost Sunday. For it is the Holy Spirit that will teach us everything we need to know; and will form our relationship with God our Father and Jesus the Son, into a loving and life giving relationship like we have never known before. It is only through the Holy Spirit that we can truly fall in love with God....through a new, renewed and enriched life of prayer where we come to know God as our Father.

This life is open to us through a very simple form of prayer. I encourage you to take some time this week, but especially next Saturday on the Vigil of Pentecost, to pray for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit this Pentecost. It is a very simple prayer: “Come, Holy Spirit.” You can't get more simple than that! If you would like more of a method to your prayer, that you can pray on your own or in a group, try the following vigil prayer format.

For your vigil prayer, consider praying through these steps:

- Open with the Sign of the Cross and light a candle symbolizing the presence of the Holy Spirit;
- Stop, breathe, let your heart and mind be silent, and remember that you are in the presence of God;
- Begin to pray “Come Holy Spirit.” Begin to ask the Holy Spirit to come upon you, to move in your heart, mind, and body;
- There is power in verbalizing our prayer; continue to pray “Come Holy Spirit” out loud, and continue to open your heart and mind to his movement, and to entrust yourself entirely to the will of God, trusting that he is moving and he is present;
- Ask for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon you, in your life. Be free to ask for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit in specific areas of your life where there are strongholds of sin or brokenness, where there is a need for healing, where there is doubt or fear and a need for understanding and peace, or any other specific places that you feel called to ask for the Spirit to come;
- Stay in this prayer, wait, and remain open to gifts of the Holy Spirit. Spend as much time as you need, as the Spirit invites you to wait;
- If you are gathered with a community, pray with each other for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit, pray for an outpouring upon your community, continuing to pray “Come Holy Spirit.”

Conclude your prayer by asking the Holy Spirit if there are any specific ways He is calling you to respond. Ask what He desires for your life of faith beyond this event of prayer. Spend some time in silence allowing the Lord to speak to your heart. Journal about these things so you can return to them at a later time for further prayerful reflection.

May this Pentecost bring an outpouring of the Holy Spirit on each of our lives; upon our families; and on our parish and school as a whole. May the Holy Spirit teach us how to pray in a new way; in a gifted way; and draw us closer in loving relationship with God our Father!

The evening will feature the following dynamic guest speakers:

Rev. Patrick J. Howell, S.J., is a professor of pastoral theology in the School of Theology and Ministry, at Seattle University. He has been instrumental in founding the graduate programs in pastoral ministry. As dean, 2000-2006, he inaugurated a degree in pastoral counseling with an emphasis on attention to severe mental illness. His publications include: *Reducing the Storm to a Whisper: the Story of a Breakdown* and *As Sure as the Dawn: A Spiritguide through Times of Darkness*. Fr. Howell’s viewpoint comes from his personal experience with mental illness as well as pastoral perspectives.

Helen Teresa “Trez” Buckland, has over 40 years of classroom experience spanning grades K-post secondary education. She holds a PhD in Nursing and teaches at the University of Washington. Much of her life’s work was shaped after her son’s diagnosis of schizophrenia at age 17. Trez was honored with Navos Mental Health’s *Expanding Horizons* award in recognition for her efforts to support recovery and eliminate the stigma for young adults who live with the challenges of mental illness. Trez has been involved with NAMI for over 35 years. She is currently a member of St. Catherine of Siena Parish and is a past member of St. Luke’s Parish.

Deacon Roy Harrington, has been the Pastoral Coordinator and deacon at St Benedict Parish since July 2014. He previously served as the Director of Deacons for the Archdiocese of Seattle from 2011 to 2015. In his secular career, he was involved operations and emergency management in public transit services and served our nation for 30 years as a human resources officer in the Army Reserve, retiring at the rank of colonel in 2009. He holds a BA from the University of Washington and an MPA from Seattle University. He is passionate about working with veterans to address their mental health needs.
