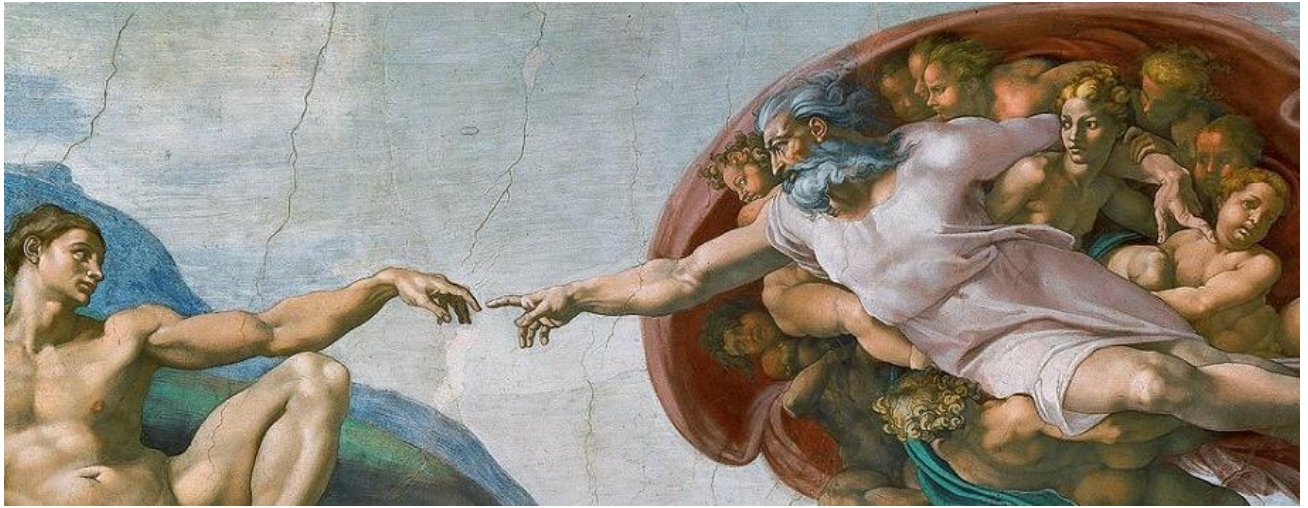

## Pastor's Letter:



*The Creation of Adam by Michelangelo*

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This past week I was in the library at the Palisades Retreat Center pondering my homily for Pentecost Sunday. Above the fireplace is a reproduction of Michelangelo's famous work showing God the Father's creation of Adam. There is a lot to say about this work of art, but one part of the piece really caught my attention as I reflected upon gift of the Holy Spirit to the Church on Pentecost.

Notice the finger of the Father as it reaches out to Adam's finger. The fingers do not touch; there is slight gap. I looked closely at the space between the fingers and it came to me that the gap between the finger of God and the finger of man represents faith. Faith is what closes the gap and allows the two fingers to meet in a form of communion.....and ultimately in God's embrace of man. Depending upon our life situations, sometimes the gap is a large one; sometimes is a very slight one.

Once a person comes to faith, it is the Holy Spirit of God that begins to close the gap. The Catechism teaches us that the desire for God is written in every human heart as man was created by God for God (CCC #27). The gift of the Holy Spirit, to the Church and to each of us in Baptism and Confirmation, enables us to enter into a meaningful relationship with God who is our father. The Holy Spirit literally "bridges the gap" and makes it possible for us to touch God and encounter God through Christ our Lord, especially in the sacraments. This encounter is one of love and opens us to God's loving embrace. The Holy Spirit makes this possibility a reality.

As we celebrate Pentecost, may the Pentecost prayer become ours: "Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit, and they shall be created, and you will renew the face of the earth. Amen!"
