### STATE LEGISLATIVE UPDATES

Please contact your state senators to vote "No" on EHB 1044. This bill concerns health plan coverage for the voluntary termination of a pregnancy. Two amendments offered on the House floor did **not protect the right of conscience** in the bill as passed. Insurance plans in Washington now offer abortion coverage as an **option** not a **requirement** coupled with maternity care. **This bill would require it.** There is an upcoming public hearing on this bill scheduled in Senate Committee on Health Care on April 1, 2013, at 10am. This bill is sponsored by Planned Parenthood and NARAL.
