PERPETUAL ADORATION

WITH LAST WEEK'S NEWS that the Boy Scouts of America voted to allow membership to avowed homosexuals (scouts only, not scout leaders), in all of the political spats and moral debates, it's easy to miss the overarching factor that is really in play: the virtue of chastity. Everyone, regardless of vocation, is called to exercise chastity, and in doing so "comes under the cardinal virtue of temperance, which seeks to permeate the passions and appetites of the senses with reason" (CCC 2341). So you see that we are not expected to fulfill every whim of physical desire; we are not to simply give in to sexual desire - heterosexual or homosexual - just because it's there. Instead we have to order ourselves toward God, and achieving God's will for us can only come by dedicating ourselves to a life of prayer. The greatest prayer is of course the holy sacrifice of the Mass, but if you can find one extra hour each week, adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is a fruitful way to spend time with the Lord. There is one open hour on Thursday from 11 pm-midnight, as well as a few 2-3 am hours during the week.
