# 15<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

This Sunday we hear the parable of the Good Samaritan, a story so popular it has become part of our normal lexicon:

## Good Samaritan

*n*

1. a figure in one of Christ's parables (Luke 10:30-37) who is an example of compassion towards those in distress
2. a kindly person who helps another in difficulty or distress

Some recent research polls indicate that less than 30% of U.S. Catholics attend Mass every Sunday. Our faith teaches us that we are nourished and sustained by the power of the Sacraments. So, tragically, over 50 million U.S. Catholics are spiritually malnourished and without power. Think of panic some have when their cell phones alert them of low battery. If only our souls had a similar warning indicator.

As disciples of Jesus, we are called to help those in distress. Today's parable leaves no doubt about who our neighbor is — anyone (without distinction of race or relationship) who needs our help; nor about how we should love him — by taking pity on him, being compassionate towards his spiritual or corporal needs; and it is not just a matter of having the right feelings towards him: we must do something, we must generously serve him. It is always inspiring to see the outpouring of charity and goodwill after a natural disaster. Last year after Hurricane Sandy devastated New York and left many without power, this photo appeared:



A family that had their power restored shared with others so they could replenish their cell phone batteries and contact loved ones. They were *Good Samaritans* to their neighbors in need. How much more important to help those who are spiritually in need? As disciples we must strive to find ways to share Christ's love and compassion, never distancing ourselves from others' needs, but to evangelize by supplying the *spiritual* extension cords and power strips, encouraging and empowering others to return to grace of the Mass and the sacraments.

The procedure is simple: Prior to the beginning of Mass, ask a sacristan that a low gluten host be consecrated for you at Mass. At the time of communion, proceed to the credence table, under the shrine of the Blessed Mother. The sacristan will administer Holy Communion to you at the time. **TODAY NO ONE IN OUR WORLD FEELS RESPONSIBLE;** we have lost a sense of responsibility for our brothers and sisters. We have fallen into the hypocrisy of the priest and the Levite whom Jesus described in the parable of the Good Samaritan: we see our brother half dead on the side of the road, and perhaps we say to ourselves: "poor soul...!", and then go on our way. It's not our responsibility, and with that we feel reassured, assuaged. The culture of comfort, which makes us think only of ourselves, makes us insensitive to the cries of other people, makes us live in soap bubbles which, however lovely, are insubstantial; they offer a fleeting and empty illusion which results in indifference to others; indeed, it even leads to the globalization of indifference. In this globalized world, we have fallen into globalized indifference. We have become used to the suffering of others: it doesn't affect me; it doesn't concern me; it's none of my business!
