Exciting happening! My mom and I were praying at PP this afternoon when a woman pulled over to talk with us. She had her 5 kids in the van with her and said that when she was pregnant with her youngest (an absolutely beautiful little 2 year old boy), she had all the paperwork filled out for her abortion and had driven to the clinic.

When she got there though, there were people on the sidewalk with signs and she decided not to go through with it. She said that for the next few weeks she was unsure and made several more appointments, but did not keep them.

She was so thankful for the people outside praying and showing that not everyone believes that abortion is an acceptable choice. I asked her if she would ever want to share her story at a rally or something and she said she would and took my phone number.
