## Pastor's Letter:

## New Sister Parish



**Fr. Michael Somers, SVD and the Faithful of St. Thomas the Apostle Parish, Quincy, Florida**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I am pleased to announce that we will be embarking on a new sister parish relationship. For the past number of years, we have supported the ministry of Holy Name of Jesus Parish in Jamaica. Thanks to your generosity, we have contributed nearly \$100,000 to the capital and ministry needs of the parish over the years. Because all of the requested projects have been completed, we have now concluded that relationship with the parish. The bishop of the diocese in Jamaica is very grateful and appreciates our many efforts!

We now have a new and wonderful opportunity to support the ministry of a sister parish here in the southern United States: St. Thomas the Apostle Parish is located in Quincy, Florida, a small town near the southern Georgia border, between Pensacola and Tallahassee. Yes, it's a bit out of the way! The parish might be poor in material things, but it is certainly rich in its people and its enthusiasm for the faith! It happens to have the largest Hispanic membership in the Diocese of Pensacola, with many children. The pastor is a great Irish missionary priest, Fr. Michael Somers. It is my hope that next spring, father and I can do a "pulpit exchange" where he will visit and minister here at St. Mark for a week or so, and I will visit St. Thomas. For our part, we will have an opportunity to really assist and build up the faith of the people in Quincy. I will be meeting with Fr. Michael soon and we will enter into a sister parish covenant. Our two pastoral councils will work together so we can each learn about each other's parishes and our parishioners. I know the parish has some projects we can assist them with, especially in building up their catechetical programs for the children at the parish. Most importantly, we will be in a position to support one another in prayer.

In the coming months, we will learn more about St. Thomas the Apostle Parish and how our two parishes can help each other grow as faithful disciples of Jesus. For now, please include Fr. Somers and his parish in your prayers!

I'll be on vacation for the next two weeks, so God's blessing to you all until we meet again!
