## Pastor's Letter:

## The Call.....



*The Call of Simon Peter and his brother Andrew*

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

“As he passed by the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting their nets into the sea; they were fishermen. Jesus said to them, ‘Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men.’ Then they abandoned their nets and followed him.” Mark 1:16-18

Last week, with the example of Samuel, we were challenged to first receive the call of the Lord into our hearts, so we could then properly discern just what God wants with us, so our response can be true and authentic. Today, the focus is on the response itself. Peter and Andrew are the examples of what our response to the Lord Jesus must be if we are serious about being a Christian: It must be immediate and total. Nothing short of that will do.

So, the question is the same as last week: If you discern God’s call to live your baptismal promises in a particular way, are you “ALL IN”? Russell Wilson is certainly “all in” both in terms of the Seahawks but also with his faith. The first thing he did after last week’s victory was to pray.....not a bad example for us all!
