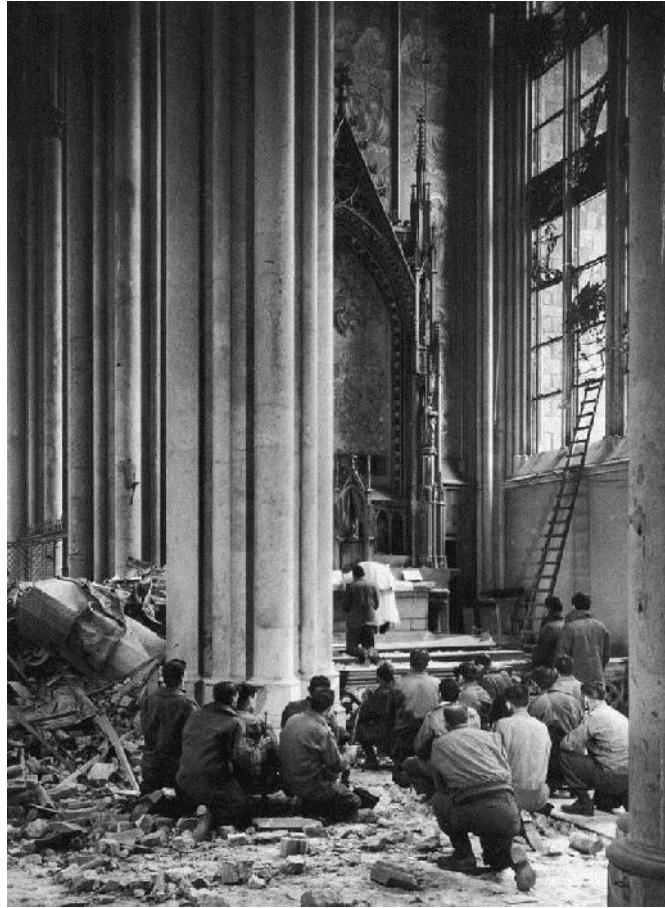

*Allied Easter Mass - Cologne Cathedral, Germany, March 1945*


