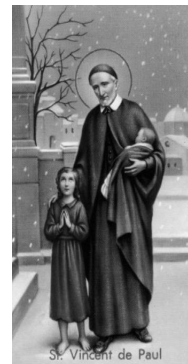


DAILY MASS CANCELLATION
