Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Archdiocese of Seattle has written a letter to all Principals and Pastors regarding the closure of schools. After much consultation with public health, CDC, local government, and Archbishop Etienne it has been decided Catholic schools will also close. If a school is in a district which has closed we are also asked to close.

Shoreline School District is closing March 12 – March 27. Since the district has closed we will follow suit.

The school is in session tomorrow, Thursday, March 12, 2020.

St. Mark will close starting Monday, March 16 – March 27. Tomorrow students will go home with books they need for the next two weeks. Please check the website for assignments daily. All work should be put into a folder to be turned into their teacher upon return on Monday, March 30. The completion of the work is mandatory for the students. The time away from school will not need to be made up if the work is complete. Please be diligent about checking the website and completing schoolwork.

I continue to pray for the protection of those most vulnerable and for patience through this time of uncertainty. You are all in my prayers. I do plan on coming to school on most days so if you have a question or concern please call or email.
