Dear friends,

An update about opportunities for prayer, confession, and adoration at Saint Mark parish church this weekend. Foremost, **please stay home if you are at-risk or have contact with those who are at-risk**. This includes the elderly, those with underlying medical conditions that put you at risk for more serious COVID-19 – or **if you have contact with those who fall into this category**. We must take seriously our obligation to care for our brothers & sisters, even if we ourselves feel well or are not at risk.

Again, I want to thank you all for your patience as we put together a plan in response to the new limits established by local law and Archbishop Etienne. ¹ I am especially grateful to our staff and those who have assisted them. Folks have been most generous, whether in volunteering to assist or offering their encouragement.

For this weekend, we will adopt a modified schedule of Stations of the Cross, confessions, and adoration. See the schedule below for more information. I especially invite you to join me on Facebook Live ((https://www.facebook.com/SaintMarkShoreline) as I offer Sunday Mass for our community at 10am.

We will be opening the church building tonight for Stations of the Cross and over the weekend (see schedule below) for confessions, adoration, and prayer. A six-foot distance between those present must be observed and there may not be more than 250 present at any given time. I ask for your assistance in diligently honoring these safety measures.

On a more personal note, I want to convey my solidarity for you all in these times. We never imagine that such things could come to pass in our time or that we would have to sacrifice in these ways. And yet, this is a time for the kind of trust and surrender to God that we see in the lives of the saints – that will make saints of us!
