



WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

O God, come to my assistance; O Lord, make haste to help me! You are my rescuer, my help; O Lord, do not delay.

Cf. Ps 70 (69): 2, 6

Would you go to a deserted place if you knew you'd find the Lord there? Jesus Himself goes off to a deserted place, modeling the human need to retreat from the world. We know that His motivation is perfectly ordered - He is not being selfish or uncharitable: this is simply part of what healthy human life looks like. He does this so that we might do likewise.

We have a second example in the crowds. While their motives were not totally selfless, there is an example worth imitating here, too. Despite Christ's remote location ('a deserted place', recall), crowds followed Him. About five thousand men, not counting women and



children, we're told at the end. They left the comforts of home and familiarity of things nearby to go to Jesus.

How often do we leave everything behind to go be with Jesus? Is it not the case even when we go far from home, we try to bring along the comforts and familiar elements of life?

We may not be able to go far from home in our present circumstances, but we can retreat from the world. A moment, an hour, maybe even a day without distractions - focused instead on Christ & His love for us. What nourishment might the Lord have prepared for us, if only we follow after Him?

This Saturday, August 8th is the memorial of Saint Dominic. Founder of the Dominicans, he is also credited with receiving the rosary from the Blessed Virgin in a vision late in his life - though there is some dispute among historians!



But the life of Saint Dominic is perhaps typified in his efforts to establishing a religious order for the promotion of morals and against heresy. From this is life's work, the Church and the world have benefited from the continuing ministry of the Dominicans, also known as the Order of Preachers.

We've got several things going on this week. The most familiar is the Carmelite 'Christmas in July' event on Saturday, August 1st. For more details, read further into the bulletin.






Saint Clare
