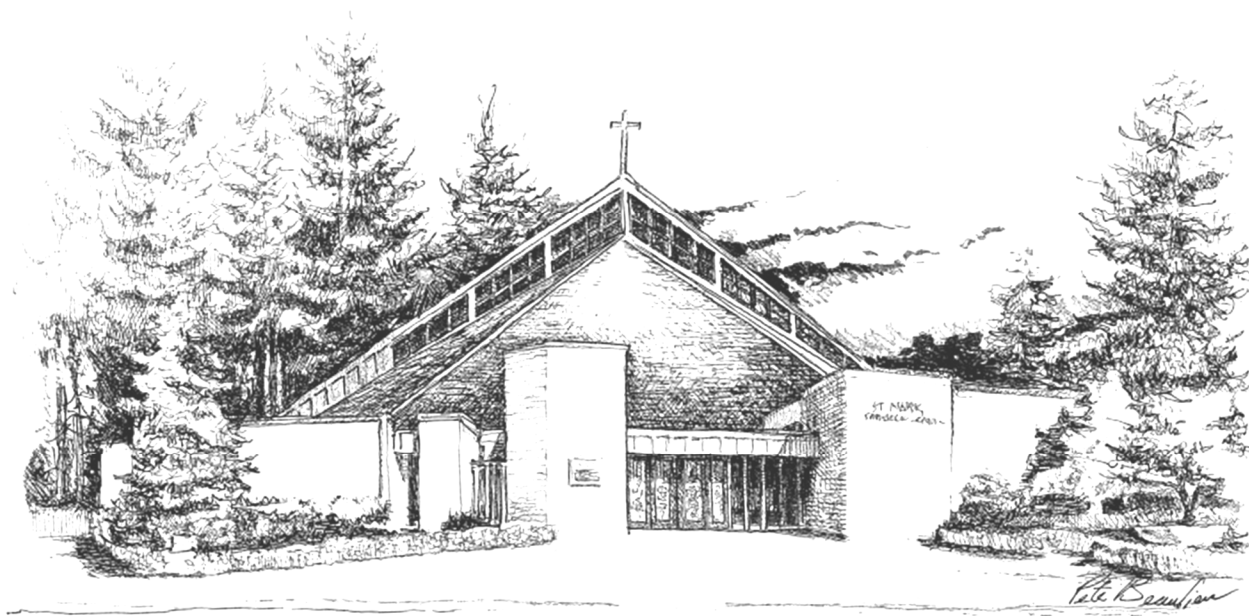

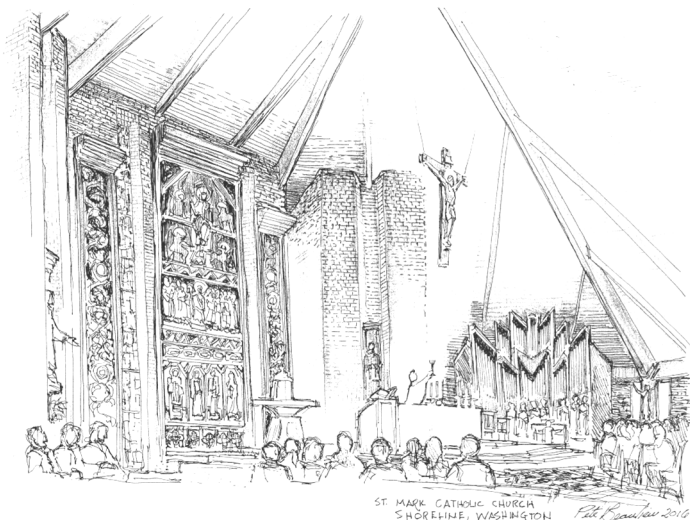

WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

Turn your eyes, O God, our shield; and look on the face of your anointed one; one day within your courts is better than a thousand elsewhere.

Cf. Ps 84 (83): 10-11

Of all the things Jesus' says, one of the more challenging ones to understand is His address to the Canaanite woman. "It is not right to take the food of the children and throw it to the dogs." (Matthew 15:26) His apparent harshness to this mother - who is asking for help on behalf of her daughter, not herself! - is a striking contrast to other occasions. Why would He say this?

It may be helpful to note that this response is *exactly* how His disciples expected Him to respond - echoing their own dismissal of her.

Yet His reaction to her persistence is not to push her away, but to highlight her great faith. He teaches the disciples - and us - a lesson using the very words of her response: "even the dogs eat the scraps...". Her words, her faith itself, rebuke the easy dismissal of those who thought they understood Jesus' purpose.

How might we need similar conversion - who do we easily ignore or dismiss in our lives?

Pope St. Pius X (August 20), is celebrated in the Church for several major works during his lifetime. Desiring to renew all things in Christ, he made great strides in three major areas: liturgical renewal, the codification of Church law, and restoration of frequent reception of Holy Communion from childhood.



While the Second Vatican Council is often credited for a great deal of the reforms we enjoy, it was preceded by many who helped lay the groundwork for its success. May we ask Pope St. Pius X to pray for us, that we too will work to renew all things in Christ.

A gentle reminder that the **dispensation by Archbishop Etienne from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass is still in effect**. If you are unable to attend - for any reason whatsoever - you need not worry that you have committed a sin.

While this dispensation is in effect, we are encouraged to make Sunday holy through other means if we do not attend Mass - reading the Scriptures for Mass, praying as a family, or even to pray as groups of families.

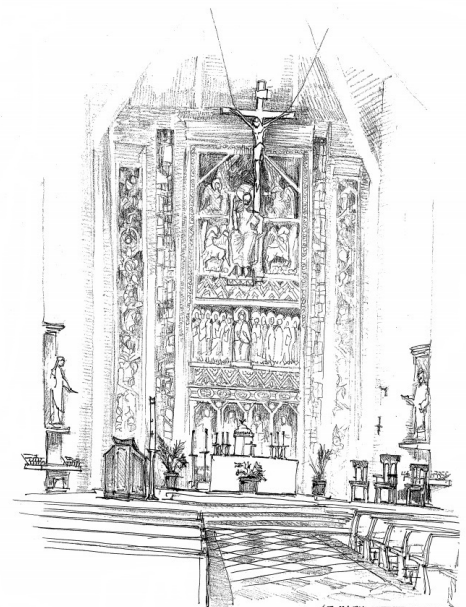

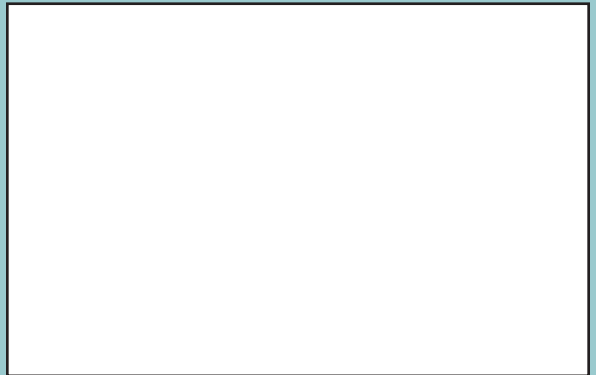

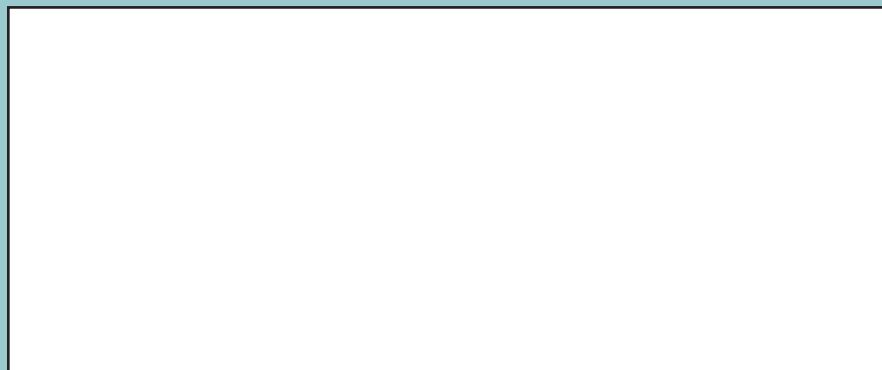
