



WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

If you, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But with you is found forgiveness, O God of Israel.

Cf. Ps 130 (129): 3-4

"My friend, how is it that you came in here without a wedding garment?"

Jesus' words today speak to a claim that is often made in defense of a common problem: dressing poorly at Mass. I find that when a homily or a bulletin article addresses dressing formally for Mass, the trope is trotted out: 'Jesus accepts me just the way I am'.

Well, yes! Jesus absolutely loves you - full stop. No conditions. You are a beloved son or daughter of God and invited to an intimate friendship with Jesus now and for all eternity.




And also, Jesus is calling each of us to be more than just acceptable: "So be perfect, just as your

heavenly Father is perfect." Mediocrity is not welcome in heaven - not even excellence is enough. Perfection is the standard to which each of us is called.

It's no sin to be imperfect.....but to **cling** to our imperfections, to choose to stay where we are rather than striving towards the end for which we are made, that is a sin that ultimately results in wailing and grinding of teeth: hell.

Clothing is an outward sign - and not even the most important one! But if we are to join in the wedding feast of the Lamb, we will need to strive to be perfect - both inside and out.

This Saturday is the memorial of Saint Ignatius of Antioch. Below is an excerpt full text a letter he wrote, included in today's Office of Readings:



"The time for my birth is close at hand. Forgive me,

my brothers. Do not stand in the way of my birth to real life; do not wish me stillborn. My desire is to belong to God. Do not, then, hand me back to the world. Do not try to tempt me with material things. Let me attain pure light. Only on my arrival there can I be fully a human being. Give me the privilege of imitating the passion of my God."
