

WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

Give me justice, O God, and plead my cause against a nation that is faithless. From the deceitful and cunning rescue me, for you, O God, are my strength.

Cf. PS 43 (42):1-2

Today - the fifth Sunday of Lent - we begin the final week of this season of preparation before the sacred Triduum and Easter celebrations. Traditionally, all statues, sacred images, and crucifixes are covered after Masses today.

It's always darkest before dawn and so before the rising Son arrives, we mark these days with a deeper solemnity and sobriety.

I'd like to encourage you consider making this week a loose novena of sorts. There are a couple of ways of doing so, but the idea is



to prepare to enter into the coming Holy Week more deliberately.

There are two ideas that come to mind. One way is to focus on the scriptures of each day, particularly the daily gospel.

The other is to read through the liturgies of the Triduum, taking time each day to read about the Chrism Mass, the Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper, the Good Friday Service of the Passion of the Lord, and the Easter Vigil in the Holy Night.

Especially through the intercession of Mary & Joseph, may we be drawn closer to the death and resurrection of Christ.

March 25 (nine months before Christ's birth) is the solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord to Mary. On this day we recall the



appearance of the archangel Gabriel to the Blessed Virgin.

As we approach the celebration of Christ's passion, death, and resurrection, we recall the promise of the conception and birth of Christ: that God, who has not abandoned us and has desired our salvation, our presence with Him is committed to our salvation.

This coming week is the final full week of the Lenten confessional schedule (below). Especially if it has been a long time, consider coming to confession in preparation for Holy Week, the Triduum celebrations, and Easter!

Shedding Light on Pornography, Part IV

A close family is a defense against pornography, as are good relationships and a strong faith, but we are all human and susceptible to temptation.

As Pope Francis tells us, the Church is called to become a field hospital for the wounded of the world. All of us are wounded starting with Original Sin and its consequences as well as our own sins. We are all beloved sons and daughters of the Father. We are not to be afraid to approach the altar of mercy; many good people struggle with this sin. Satan, the father of lies, uses shame and fear to keep souls from Jesus' mercy, but God, the most loving of Fathers, is waiting to meet with joy those who repent and to give them the grace needed to combat future temptation.

The fight for freedom from pornography can be won but a plan must be in place. There are several free apps that can help. The Victory app provides a strategic battle plan to increase motivation and a daily tracker to help understand triggers and pitfalls; then it helps the user analyze and overcome these triggers and pitfalls. The Victory app is free through the app store on Apple or Android devices, but there are several other free options as well listed on this page.

A partial list of hotlines, support groups and recovery programs is listed on this page but there are many more. Finding the right fit and a program that can be maintained, is what is most important: People are more likely to stick with a program that is convenient, accessible and welcoming.


