#### Pope Francis' Synodal Process

The word "synod" means to journey together. In this synodal process everyone around the world is invited to listen to God's word, celebrate the Eucharist and reflect upon our experience as Church.

Pope Francis has initiated a two year process for the universal Church called **For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission.** 

Pope Francis' call is for the largest consultation of the human family in history. The process has started in the Archdiocese of Seattle and in February will take place at St. Mark.

We will have three open listening sessions from which to choose. Space is limited but there is still some room available. This is an opportunity to prayerfully read the signs of the times together and discern how the Holy Spirit is calling all of us, as the Body of Christ, to accomplish our mission.

The sessions are:

**Thursday, February 24** 7:00 pm - 8:30 pm via Zoom (limited to 30 participants).

**Saturday, February 26,** 12 noon - 1:30 pm in the St. Mark gym (limited to 30 participants).

**Sunday, February 27**, 12 noon - 1:30 pm in the St. Mark gym (limited to 30 participants).




