

When he calls on me, I will answer him; I will deliver him and give him glory, I will grant him length of days.

Where is Jesus leading us? This is a question that the Christian might ask not only at Lent, but throughout their life. Particularly when times are tough, it helps to focus us not on the triumphs or difficulties of the given moment, but on their purpose. We are reminded that this life is not the goal; our time on earth is meant to help prepare us for heaven.

Lent is a time for prayer, penance, good will and to be willing to sacrifice some basic comforts in order to be closer to God.


Lent is a good time to help contribute back to our community. We can help those less fortunate by volunteering our time, we can contribute food or money to our St. Vincent de Paul society.


FASTING & ABSTINENCE				
When do I?	Fast and Abstain: Ash Wednesday & Good Friday Abstain: All Fridays during Lent			
What is?	Fasting: eating one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Abstinence: refraining from eating meat.			
Who has to?	Fast: For members of the Latin Rite, fasting is obligatory from age 18 through 59. Abstain: Persons age 14 onwards.
