

### WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

Forsake me not, O Lord, my God; be not far from me! Make haste and come to my help, O Lord, my strong salvation!

Cf. Ps 38 (37): 22-23.

As a child, the story of Zacchaeus was one of my favorites. Every kid has felt the pain of being short, surrounded by walls of taller people and unable to see whatever everyone else is looking at. There's something delightfully subversive to Zacchaeus' story - he climbs a tree (also a childhood favorite) and is rewarded for his perseverance, receiving a personal invitation by the One of Whom he was us hoping to catch a glimpse!



Though others were shocked and even disparaging of Jesus' call to Zacchaeus, it is obvious that the slightest nudge, the smallest bit of invitation from God was all he needed to finally turn his life from greed to grace.

In the midst of noise of useless debate and bad-faith arguing - particularly online - it is crucial that we not lose sight of those following in the footsteps of this little man, hidden behind larger and louder people surrounding him. May we, like Jesus, take the time to look for those who are also just one kindness away from embracing God's love.

This Tuesday, November 1, is the Solemnity of All Saints. On this holy day of obligation, we celebrate



the whole of the citizenship of heaven those declared by the Church and the great multitude whom we don't know by name, but know to be part of the communion of saints.

At our parish, we will be celebrating two Masses for this occasion - one at 9:30 am with the school and one at 6:30 pm. Together we will praise God in His saints and ask for their intercessions, that we may one day join them!

Recently a friend reminded me of <u>catafalques</u>. Essentially, it was a symbolic coffin for funerals, probably most commonly used in for soldiers who died abroad and whose bodies could not be recovered or brought home and was an essential part their requiem Masses.

On Wednesday, November 2, we won't have a catafalque, but we will celebrate **the commemoration of All Souls**, praying that our beloved dead may be hastened through purgatory to heaven. We will be celebrating

two Masses, at 9:30 am and 6:30 pm, the latter by candlelight. I hope you'll come join us in prayer!
