Seattle Catholic Young Adults Christmas Party



O people of Sion, behold, the Lord will come to save the nations, and the Lord will make the glory of his voice heard in the joy of your heart.

Cf. Is 30: 19, 30

Almighty and merciful God,
may no earthly undertaking hinder those
who set out in haste to meet your Son,
but may our learning of heavenly wisdom
gain us admittance to his company.
Who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
God, for ever and ever

John the Baptist is (rightly!) considered a bit of a wild character. Living in the wild, clothed in furs, eating locusts and honey - it seems fair to conclude that he wouldn't be the first choice for an invitation to a formal dinner!

And yet - he is one of the most important



prophets in salvation history. His was the work of announcing the coming of the Christ, of preparing the way of the Lord.

Notice that this ministry is not a *gentle* ministry! Today's Gospel illustrates this point well:


You brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the coming wrath? Produce good fruit as evidence of your repentance. And do not presume to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.'"

- Matthew 3:7-9

Here's the thing: those words aren't only meant for the Pharisees - they are directed at *us* as well! How often we are motivated not by love, holiness, or kindness in our faith but instead self-preservation! And we, too, give ourselves reassurances of justification, that nothing in our lives needs change or conversion.

In this Advent season, let us allow ourselves to be both convicted and healed by the Lord! This Thursday, December 8, is the solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary - such a major feast in the life of faith that it is a holy day of obligation.

To celebrate, we will be offering Mass both in the morning at the regular





In the meantime, check out our national basilica, taking its name from this title and feast of Mary: the basilica of the national shrine of the Immaculate Conception.

One wonderful way to prepare for celebrating the Nativity of the Lord is the sacrament of reconciliation - especially if it has been a long time. Come experience God's mercy & love!
