WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

- Father Jacob Maurer

My eyes are always on the Lord, for he rescues my feet from the snare. Turn to me and have mercy on me, for I am alone and poor.

Cf. Ps 25 (24): 15-16

This Lent we are together learning the *Pater Noster* - the 'Our Father' in Latin. New things - especially in a language most don't speak - are difficult and folks might rightly wonder what is the point of praying one of our most familiar (and important!) prayers in Latin?

The Church Herself speaks to this in the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal*: "Since the faithful from different countries come together ever more frequently, it is desirable that they know how to sing together at least some parts of the Ordinary of the Mass in Latin, especially the Profession of Faith and the Lord's Prayer, according to the simpler settings." (GIRM, #41)

I find references to be super interesting, and if you navigate to the related footnotes, you'll find five documents referenced - foremost the first document of the Second Vatican Council, Sacrosanctum Concilium. The Acta Apostolicae Sedis documents (both 54 & 56) are hard to find online, but the other two - Inter Oecumenici and Musicam Sacram - are readily available. They're not short, but they are all quite read-able, offering not only instruction but also beautiful reflections on our common prayer & worship.

To anyone having difficulty, please know you're not alone - I, for one, am still getting my mind (and tongue) around the words! I encourage you to prayerfully read these three documents - they're really quite good! And if you'd like to practice the *Pater Noster* - this captioned YouTube video may be helpful.

This year, the memorial of Saint Patrick lands on Friday. While we would normally be obliged to abstain from meat, our archbishop has graciously issued a dispensation so that we might celebrate more fully - though he encourages all who take



advantage of this dispensation to engage in another penitential or charitable act!

As we remember and celebrate Saint Patrick, may we be inspired by <u>his fervor for and proclamation of the Gospel</u> - and do likewise in our words & deeds!

The Church's tradition of the **Easter duty** (the precept that we receive communion at least annually, preferably during Easter) is a great prompt for us to **go to confession**. To

assist in that preparation, extra confession times will be offered through Lent!

Q: Will there be consolidation for schools?

A: While there are no predetermined outcomes from this work, the goal is to strengthen parish communities and Catholic schools. There are no plans or intentions for school closures as part of this process. Parish families, including school leaders, parents and parishioners, will discern the best approach for their particular school and parish community.

If a parish family comes together and more than one school is present, the new parish family leadership will evaluate the needs and opportunities present. Parish families have the opportunity to be creative and flexible in how they form one parish over time. If they decide to explore changes to the school structure within their parish family, they will work in close consultation with the Office for Catholic Schools.

Q: What does this mean for lay leaders?

A: As the Church lives out the Partners in the Gospel process, the work of Lay Ecclesial Ministers will become even more important. That is why we are investing in a new Lay Ecclesial Ministry formation program to strengthen and support our existing Lay Ecclesial Ministers while we train new ones. More information about this new program will be coming out in Spring 2023.

Q: Are other dioceses doing this?

A: Yes. Dioceses across the Unites States have implemented similar initiatives. The Partners in the Gospel Core Team has connected with many of them to hear their stories and gather recommendations. Using these insights, our archdiocesan team developed a planning and consultation model that reflects the uniqueness of the Archdiocese of Seattle. Our model is more consultative, embraces our cultural diversity and history, and reflects our large geography that includes concentrated city centers as well as suburban and rural communities.

While we appreciate the guidance and insights from other dioceses, success in the Archdiocese of Seattle will come from the creativity and collaboration of each parish family, led by the Holy Spirit.
