WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

- Father Jacob Maurer

I have risen, and I am with you still, alleluia. You have laid your hand upon me, alleluia. Too wonderful for me, this knowledge, alleluia, alleluia.

Cf. Ps 139 (138): 18, 5-6



Happy Easter! At long last, we have arrived at the empty tomb. Having meditated on the Passion and Death of the Lord, we come to the joy of His resurrection.

As we have taken our time walking along the *via dolorosa*, so the Church encourages us to rest a while in the celebration of Christ's triumph. In fact, the celebration of Easter spans not only one or even a few but eight days - an octave of solemnities. Starting today, we celebrate every day through next Sunday (Divine Mercy Sunday) as Easter. Each day of the octave of Easter holds the rank of solemnity, the highest order of feast for the greatest celebration that we know!

Chapel of the Resurrection Though it may not be feasible to put together an Easter feast for eight days (to say nothing of the dishes!), let us be sure to set aside time during each of these days to glorify and praise God for the wonders of His Son's return to life - and the new life that He offers to the world.

One way to keep the Lord front and center is to meditate on the readings for each day of the octave - they are available online from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops website.

Consider spending time as a family listening to the Gospel of each day and considering together what it might have been like to live through these days - especially after having witnessed Jesus' death!

Consider also the Easter sequence <u>Victimae paschali</u> <u>laudes</u> ('Christians, to the Paschal Victim') - the special sung poem that is offered Easter Sunday and every day of the octave. The words remind us of the cost of our salvation, and the joy of the empty tomb - eliciting the proclamation that echoes still today:

He is risen! He is risen indeed!

Easter eggs are a popular way of celebrating the resurrection of the Lord. Though children especially anticipate finding the plastic variety (ideally filled with sweets!), this practice is steeped with history & tradition.

Legend holds that Mary Magdalene went to Emperor Tiberius Caesar in Rome to proclaim Christ's resurrection. Mocking her, he scoffed that Jesus was no more risen than the egg in her hand was red - and it immediately turned red. The emperor, thus believing her, condemned Pilate for having executed an innocent man.

May we, like Mary, proclaim Christ's resurrection!
