

Cry out with joy to God, all the earth; O sing to the glory of his name. O render him glorious praise, alleluia.

"Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?" (<u>Luke 24:32</u>)

Popular art of the sacred heart of Jesus usually depicts it surrounded by a crown of thorns, pierced, with flames emitting from the top. Each element conveys some aspect of Christ's life, death, and resurrection - and His promises

the Lord to His Apostles.

When was the last time you were so fervent, so impassionately devoted, so delightfully excited, that it felt like your heart was 'burning within' as the disciples speak of in today's Gospel? We are often enthusiastic about people and things we enjoy - and rightfully so. As Saint Ignatius reminds us, "all is gift, all is grace"!

As we celebrate the many blessings we enjoy on earth, may we ask the Lord to inflame our hearts with enthusiasm for Him - that we might go out and proclaim His Gospel to all. This Tuesday, April 25, is the feast of Saint Mark, evangelist and patron of our parish. He is symbolized as a winged lion, from the vision of the prophet Ezekiel.



When the four symbols of the evangelists are shown together (as in the iconostasis behind the altar at our parish), it is called a *tetramorph* from the Greek words 'four' & 'forms'.

Like Saint Mark, may our proclamation of the Gospel have the fierceness of a lion, proudly proclaiming the resurrection of the Lord and His coming again in glory!
