WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

- Father Jacob Maurer

O sing a new song to the Lord, for he has worked wonders; in the sight of the nations he has shown his deliverance, alleluia.

Cf. Ps 98 (97): 1-2

One of the ways we can tell people are related is family resemblance. In part, this is physical: hair color, eyes, and other bodily features clearly inherited from our parents and beyond. We also inherit mannerisms, attitudes, and habits - sometimes mimicking our family deliberately, other times quite unconsciously.

It's a delightful thing to see how an infant son falls asleep on his father's lap, crossing his arms the same way as dad. Or how a young daughter throws her head back in laughter in the same manner and tone as her mother.



So, when Jesus today replies to Philip that He is in the Father and the Father is in Him, we are not in entirely alien territory! We have experienced how this can be true on a natural, human level.

But the unity between Jesus and His Father is also something more: together with the Holy Spirit, they are one in a way that is supernatural, that is divine. Wherever Jesus is, so are also the Father and the Holy Spirit.

This is a mystery worth spending some time on! What does it mean for us to have a relationship with the Father? How does He continue to reveal Himself to us? May we ask the Lord to help us to better know Him, His Father, and the Holy Spirit.

May 13 is the memorial of **Our Lady of Fatima**. Appearing six times to three children in Fatima, Portugal, Mary exhorted them to devote themselves to the Trinity and to daily prayer of the rosary for world peace.



Accompanying her

appearances was a special miracle, now called 'the miracle of the sun'. As tens of thousands gathered - believers and skeptics alike - the sun appeared to dance in the sky, rushing towards and then away from spectators, but causing no harm to anyone. Read more online.

One of my favorite annual events at the school is the **Missoula Children's Theatre**. In just five days, our students audition, learn their parts, and rehearse together



daily in order to perform at the end of the week. This year they are doing an original musical adaptation of *Hansel and Gretel*.

It's an intimidating thing, getting up in front of people to speak, sing, and act in character. And yet, with the help of their directors, a great number of our students will do just this!

Come see their performances, happening on Saturday, May 13th in the school gym at 3:00 pm & 6:30 pm. It is sure to be a blast!
