WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

- Father Jacob Maurer

Men of Galilee, why gaze in wonder at the heavens? This Jesus whom you saw ascending into heaven will return as you saw him go, alleluia.

Cf. Acts 1: 11

Here in the Archdiocese of Seattle, we celebrate **the solemnity of the Ascension** (transferred from its traditionally observed day of 10 days before Pentecost - last Thursday). The traditional observance has some neat significance. To start, it marks the triumph of Christ over suffering and death: as Jesus spent forty days in the desert, so He ascended to the Father forty days after His resurrection.



On the fiftieth day the promised Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles - empowering them to do as Jesus commanded them before His ascension: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing

them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit".

In the days, months, and years that followed, the Apostles went out to the four corners of the known world - with enviable zeal & faith! May we take this week to consciously prepare for the celebration of Pentecost, inviting and giving permission for the Holy Spirit to ignite (or re-ignite) our own faith:

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created, and you shall renew the face of the earth.

Next Sunday is the solemnity of Pentecost.
Considered the birthday of the Church, we recall the day when the Apostles, having received the Holy Spirit - miraculously made apparent in the tongues of fire above



them and their ability to be understood by all those in their presence - went forth from Jerusalem to proclaim the Gospel.

As we celebrate this day, and move from the Easter season into Ordinary Time, I hope you'll consider coming to the Pentecost Extended Vigil (Saturday, May 27 at 5 pm) to celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit!

A gentle reminder that this Thursday, May 25th, from 5pm-7pm, is our annual **McTeachers Night** at the local McDonald's off of Ballinger Way. Our school staff, principal, and I will be there - come by to visit, enjoy your favorite fast-food treat, and support Saint Mark Catholic Classical School.
