WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

Blest be God the Father, and the Only Begotten Son of God, and also the Holy Spirit, for he has shown us his merciful love.

Happy Trinity Sunday! Though back in Ordinary Time, we are blessed with several celebrations of feasts and solemnities - today being the solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity.

Much ink has been spilled in Christians' efforts to explain the 'what' of the Trinity. The words of Saint Paul remind us of the 'why' of the Trinity as he greets the Corinthians in today's second reading: "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you."




To be clear, the virtues here (grace, love, fellowship) are not specific or isolated to any one Person of the Trinity. Rather, it is that the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit are inviting us to join them in their union

The Heavenly and Earthly Trinities of love. In short, Bartolomé Esteban Murillo we are invited to

**be united with God and each other** - taking Their intimate union as our model.

Though we may not grasp the 'what' of the Trinity, we celebrate today the 'why': that God so loved the world that He gave His only Son so that all who believe in Him may have eternal life! This invitation is offered to us and to the whole world - may we receive & proclaim it! There's a popular video from Lutheran Satire called "<u>St. Patrick's Bad</u> <u>Analogies</u>" in which Saint Patrick is depicted struggling to explain the Holy Trinity in a simple



but accurate way. His final (exasperated!) effort simply quotes the Athanasian Creed. Happily, today's solemnity does not require us to perfectly articulate the mysteries of the Holy Trinity. We praise Father, Son, and Holy Spirit for the great love we have received.

Please join me in praising God and praying for Father Sylvester Chanda and Father John Paul Tomassi, ordained yesterday (June 3, 2023) for the Archdiocese of Seattle.
