Bottles can be returned to the church the weekend of July 9th or to the Next Step Pregnancy Services clinic in Lynnwood.



WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

- Father Jacob Maurer

The Lord is the strength of his people, a saving refuge for the one he has anointed. Save your people, Lord, and bless your heritage, and govern them for ever.

Cf. Ps 28 (27): 8-9

Jesus tells the Apostles and us "**Fear no one**." His counsel speaks to the heart of every Christian - after all, with God on our side, there is nothing that has power over us.

Yet isn't it the case that fear is a driving force behind so much of what we do? Fear of being rejected or alone, of missing out, of losing something we treasure or of having to bear a burden that we do not wish to carry - these and so many other fears can and do urge us to make decisions that we might otherwise reject.



Though we often *do* face struggles and sorrows in the world, the Lord invites us to place our hope & trust in Him. The key is to remember that the final victory is Christ's - and in our union with Him, that victory is ours as well.

Rather than being afraid to feel fearful (a dreadful spiral, that!), fear is an

occasion to entrust ourselves anew to God. How freeing it is to realize that we are overly fearful of something, to renounce that fear, and to replace that fear with joy!

Though this is the work of a lifetime, it is work we can do every day. One prayer we might make, even daily, is the *Litany of Humility*, praying that Jesus might deliver us from fear and help us to confidently trust in Him.
