



WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

- Father Jacob Maurer

Let my prayer come into your presence. Incline your ear to my cry for help, O Lord.

Cf. Ps 88 (87): 3

Thank you for your prayers last week while I was on retreat. Though I was not present in the community, you were not far from my mind or prayers throughout the week, particularly in my celebration of daily Masses.

Just before my retreat, I was talking with our school principal about this time of year - we both agree that time seems to move so much *faster* once fall arrives. November is already half over, Christmas will be here before we know it, and there's yet so much to do! With the many demands of the season, it could be fairly easy to forget or fail to set aside time with the Lord.



Today's Gospel pokes hard at this reality. The parable of the ten virgins is, at its heart, a parable

about ten people who were eagerly awaiting one that they loved. But half of them found themselves caught flat-footed - of all things, because they failed to properly prepare!

In a time when preparations are nearly all material (cleaning, food, presents, and more!), there is no small consolation to be found in what the Lord is *not* asking of us. The only gift He hopes for is us - our very selves. And this is the one gift that we already have ready!

As we move towards the busy-ness of the holiday season, be sure to set aside time with Jesus in quiet & prayer. Thus filled with grace, you'll be ready for whatever comes your way!

This Saturday we will celebrate the dedication of *two* major basilicas in Rome: the Basilica of Saint Peter and the



Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls. Last week we celebrated the dedication of the cathedral of Rome, the Lateran Basilica. Now we celebrate the two most famous Apostles of the Church - Saint Peter and Saint Paul.



May we ask their intercession that in our lives we may model their faithfulness and zeal in following Jesus!

This week at Saint Mark Catholic Classical School, we are undergoing our regular accreditation process.
