St. Mark Catholic Classical School is looking for a music teacher for K-8

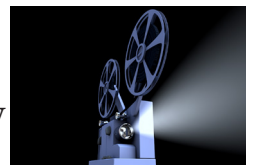

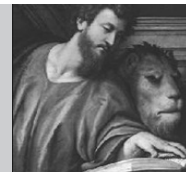

A homeless family of 5 contacted us last week in need of immediate assistance with gas money and clothing. The family's tent had been robbed and vandalized and all their clothes and other possessions were either taken or burned and ruined. They needed gas money to attend the funeral for the father's mother that was being held in Bellingham last Sunday and clothing for a 6-year-old girl and boys ages 8 and 13. Thankfully, the family's tent was replaced by Mary's Place, a local shelter, where the family is on the waiting list for safe housing. Through the generosity of St. Mark parishioners, St. Vincent de Paul was able to provide this family with a \$25 gift card to pay for gas and \$150 in Goodwill gift cards to help replace their clothing.

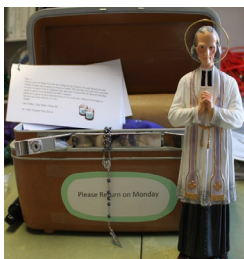
