New Business

- I. Parish Updates: Father reported positive attendance to Multicultural Dinner. Stations will begin Fridays in Lent.
- II. Relationship with Finance Council:
 - a. Dirk Bartram presented additional data of Sunday offerings. Council noted average annual attendee giving has increased since 2019, though overall collection has decreased.
 - b. Sean Malone presented and reiterated council's role in budget process. Pastoral council may "provide recommendations for parish priorities, directions, and policies" in order to determine parish priorities and goals (Many Gifts: Consultative Leadership, 2021). Council discussed how to set such priorities, as well as what items may be a priority in light of parish's financial situation. Father suggested priorities are: staffing, worship, and catechesis. Discussed priority of school and other hypotheticals.
- III. Partners in the Gospel: Council discussed reactions from parishioners regarding announcement of Partners in the Gospel. Analyzed attractions of parish + type of parishioners attracted to St. Mark. Ideas for increasing attraction included: monthly social events (all-parish), small interest groups meeting regularly, trying new things in worship (adoration, liturgy of the hours, etc.), lively social hour after Masses.
