

We are seeking a Facilities Maintenance Manager for St. Mark Parish & School The facilities maintenance manager serves as the Lord's steward of the parish and school buildings and grounds and provides for the daily and long-term care of systems including electrical, plumbing, lighting and heating (natural gas boilers), with an eye for safety and security, as if he/she were the owner.

Duties/experience: Diagnose problems and make repairs to facilities, with broad experience with construction, carpentry, painting, plumbing and electrical, with a focus on avoiding the need to hire outside contractors, other than for established regular services. Performs preventative maintenance to buildings and grounds to minimize plumbing, mechanical, electrical, lighting and heating system (boilers) failures. Maintains an inventory of cleaning supplies, restroom supplies and equipment
