

Stewardship Update

Thank you to the parishioners who have pledged \$337,000 toward our need of \$946,000. We are 36% toward our goal, with so far 111 households having made a stewardship pledge. More than half of the pledges received so far were increased pledges from the year before, and 28 are new pledges, so this is very encouraging.

Another 74 parish households, regularly give online, but have not yet made a pledge. This is potentially another \$131,000 in giving occurring already. If you think you may be in this group, please make a pledge to correspond with your giving, so that we can update our totals accordingly.
