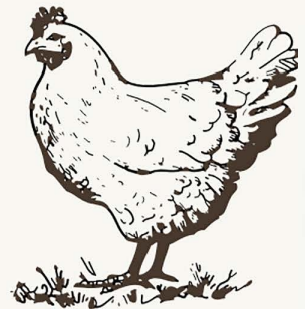

Email Safety Reminder

There has been a recent increase in email scams where the scammer pretends to be a staff member. Please always remember to:

- Check the email address of the sender not just the name displayed as that is easily editable. Email addresses should end in the domain of the organization (i.e. seattlearch.org).
- Staff will never ask for you to personally purchase gift cards or wire funds. Any charitable request like this will come through official communications like the weekly email or bulletin and have very clear instructions (i.e. for SVDP Christmas Baskets or Teacher Appreciation).
