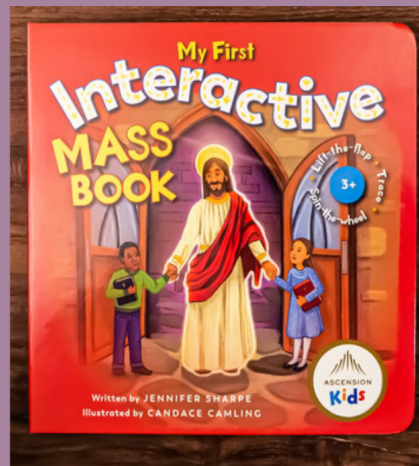

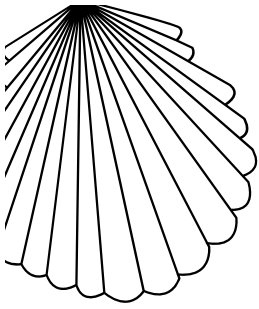
The FIRST SUNDAY of each month is Welcome/ Registration Sunday. Please look for the table in the narthex next weekend, February 1st & 2nd.
