ADVOCACY NEEDED!

Important bills are before the Washington State legislature regarding clergy reporting child abuse. **SB 5375 and HB 1211 DO NOT provide exemption for confession.** Under these bills, priests would be REQUIRED to break the seal of confession or go to jail. **SB 5665 DOES allow for clergy exemption for confession.**

PLEASE call your representative asap to support SB 5665 and REJECT SB 5375 & HB 1211. Action is critical.

Floral Committee - Members create arrangements from contributions of fresh flowers and place throughout St. Mark church.


The parish office will be <u>closed</u> on Monday, February 17th, in observance of Presidents' Day.




