## ADVOCACY NEEDED!

Important bills are before the Washington State legislature regarding clergy reporting child abuse. **SB 5375 and HB 1211 DO NOT provide exemption for confession.** Under these bills, priests would be REQUIRED to break the seal of confession or go to jail. **SB 5665 DOES allow for clergy exemption for confession.**

PLEASE call your representative asap to support SB 5665 and REJECT SB 5375 & HB 1211. Action is critical.

### Come find out more about:

**Lectors** - Lectors proclaim the Word of the Lord through Scripture during each Mass.

**Sacristans** - Sacristans assist the priest by making preparations before daily and weekend Masses, then afterwards cleaning and setting up for the next one.

**Altar Servers** - Altar Servers support the Mass and other liturgies. It is open to children beginning in fifth grade as well as young men in high school and beyond.

**Eucharistic Ministers** - Eucharistic Ministers at Mass assist the priest in distributing the Body of Christ during communion.

**Choir & Cantors** - The Choir & Cantors provide engaging music during liturgies for all gathered for worship.

Please join us as we pray the rosary together.

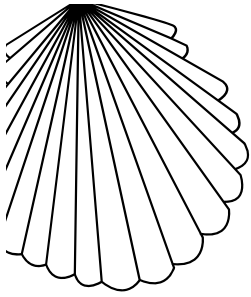
