We served about 1,135 salmon dinners starting with serving about 100 dinners the first night to about 250 on the final night. We were able to cover our expenses, and it was an enjoyable time for food & fellowship.



We didn't quite know how it would turn out when we first started – this type of dinner was successful at Fr. Ross' previous parish, and he wanted to try it here as well. Fr. Ross' signature salmon seasoning recipe was used.
