



Dear St. Matthew & St. Mark Parishioners,

I wanted to update you on the work being done to create the strategic plan for the combined St. Mark/St. Matthew School for the school year 2026-27. Tom Martin from St. Mark has been leading the Strategic Planning Steering Committee. Other members include Kathy Keck, Leo Van Hollebeke, Ruth Foisy and Ian Audette from St. Mark. From St. Matthew, Julie Prepotente, Rick O'Leary, John Hickman and Monica Williams are participating.

The Strategic Planning Steering Committee is building on the recommendations from the earlier task force. As a reminder those recommendations that I approved in February were:

- While there is an urgent need to address the economic reality, the task force recommends slowing down to ensure ample time for prayer, discernment, and study.
- As such, for the 2025-2026 school year, both schools will operate separately, but with slimmed budgets.
- During this time, we will develop a focused and intentional strategic plan for a sustainable Catholic school in the parish family.

The steering committee has met 3 times and has organized the following work groups that will include members of the school communities along with parish leaders.

#### Curriculum -

- What elements of the 2 schools' curriculums should be retained for a vibrant sustainable school?
- What new programs/resources should be considered?
- Finances Budget and tuition
- Community
  - o How do we establish a strong community for the combined parish family school?
  - How do we retain and attract more families?
- Strategic Location of the combined school and relationship to the Partners in the Gospel process.

Each school is preparing for the 2025-26 school year, operating separately. These preparations include actively reducing costs of each school. The strategic plan will help organize the transition to a combined school for the 2026-27 school year.

We invite you to an in-person update on the process and allow you a chance to ask questions at two open forums. You may attend any or all the sessions.
