SOME CHANGES IN OUR CELEBRATION OF MASS

We're making some minor but important changes in the way we sing the ORDINARY of the Mass and we've placed new yellow worship cards in the pews to help.

The **ORDINARY** is the parts of the liturgy that we sing every week: Kyrie, Glory to God, Sanctus, Acclamation, Great Amen and Agnus Dei. The Propers are the parts that change every week: the readings, the antiphons and the Presider's prayers.

In singing the ORDINARY we're striving for a balance between Latin and English: Latin for the short familiar responses and English for the longer 'Glory to God' and 'We proclaim your death...' We have many new faces attending Mass and English is more user-friendly for those learning about the Catholic faith.

The second change is a new and more elaborate 'Amen' at the end of the Consecration. Our current 'Amen' is perfunctorily short and certainly doesn't adequately express the awesome mystery we've just witnessed. Nor does it approach Transcendent Beauty, which is always one of the goals of our weekly celebrations. So, we've now extended the Amen with what's known as a 'Jubilus,' the ecstatic musical extension of a syllable when we literally lift our voices to God.




If you have not signed up for an hour, but would like to stop in for a visit, you may do so, between the start of Adoration on Friday morning, until the church is locked at 4pm.
