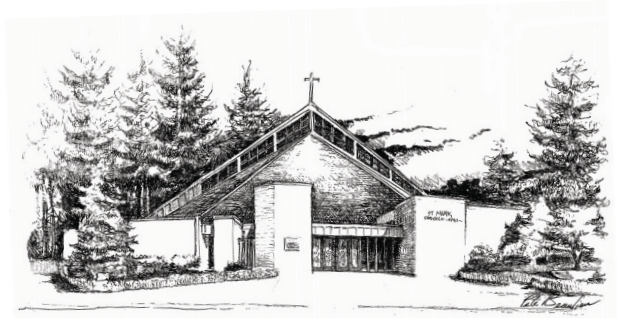

Jubilee 2025 Pilgrimage Opportunity

As part of the Jubilee Year 2025, your Pastoral Council is excited to announce a special opportunity for grace and indulgence through a **bus pilgrimage to the National Sanctuary of Our Sorrowful Mother in Portland (The Grotto) on August 13th**. The Grotto is a place of peace, prayer, and natural beauty. **It is an approved Jubilee pilgrimage site.**

What is the Jubilee indulgence? It is a traditional part of a Jubilee year. It is a plenary indulgence which can be applied either to yourself or deceased loved ones. The conditions for obtaining the Jubilee indulgence are to receive the sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist, pray for the intentions of the Holy Father, and to make a pilgrimage locally or to Rome.

Important details: Sign up for the bus occurs after Masses June 14 & 15 in narthex. \$20 individual; \$60 family. Payment is due at the time of sign up. First come, first serve basis. The bus will leave and return from St Mark. Bring your lunch/snacks. Wear weather-appropriate clothes and comfortable walking shoes. All areas of The Grotto are handicapped accessible.
